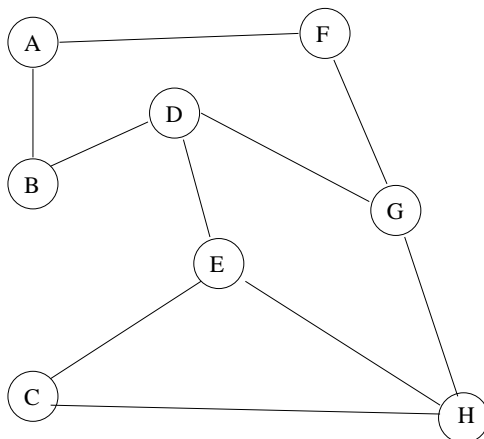


Effiziente Algorithmen und Datenstrukturen I

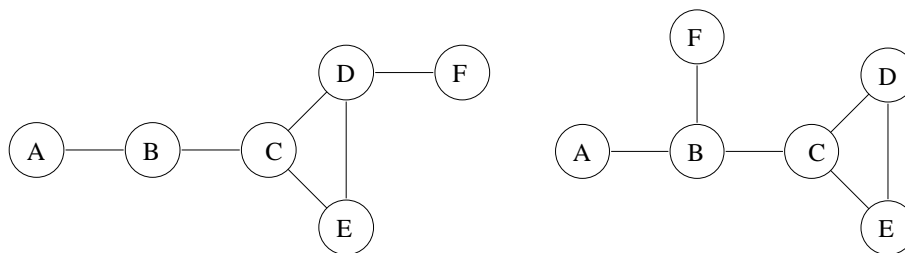
Aufgabe 1
